



## **Christmas Fayre Survey 2017 – prize draw: terms and conditions**

2. All entrants must provide the Council with their name and address. The Council will only ever use these details for the purposes of administering this prize draw and will not publish them or provide them to anyone without the permission of the entrant.
3. Only one entry will be accepted per person.
4. The deadline for receiving entries is midnight on Wednesday 31 January 2018. The winner will be notified during week commencing Monday 5 February 2018.
5. The winner will be selected at random.
6. The winner will be contacted personally by an officer of the Council.
7. If the prize is unclaimed after 28 days it will be deemed to have been forfeited and the Council reserves the right to either offer the prize to the entrant whose name is next drawn at random, or to re-offer the prize in any future competition.
8. The prize must be taken as stated and cannot be deferred. There will be no cash alternative.
9. The Council does not accept any responsibility for late or lost entries due to the Internet/postal services. Proof of emailing will not be accepted as proof of delivery and no responsibility can be accepted for entries lost, delayed, mislaid or for any technical failure or for any event which may cause the competition to be disrupted or corrupted.
10. Entrants must supply full details as required above, and comply with all rules to be eligible for the prize. No responsibility is accepted for ineligible entries or entries made fraudulently.
11. The Council reserves the right to cancel the competition at any stage, if deemed necessary in their opinion, and if circumstances arise outside of its control.
